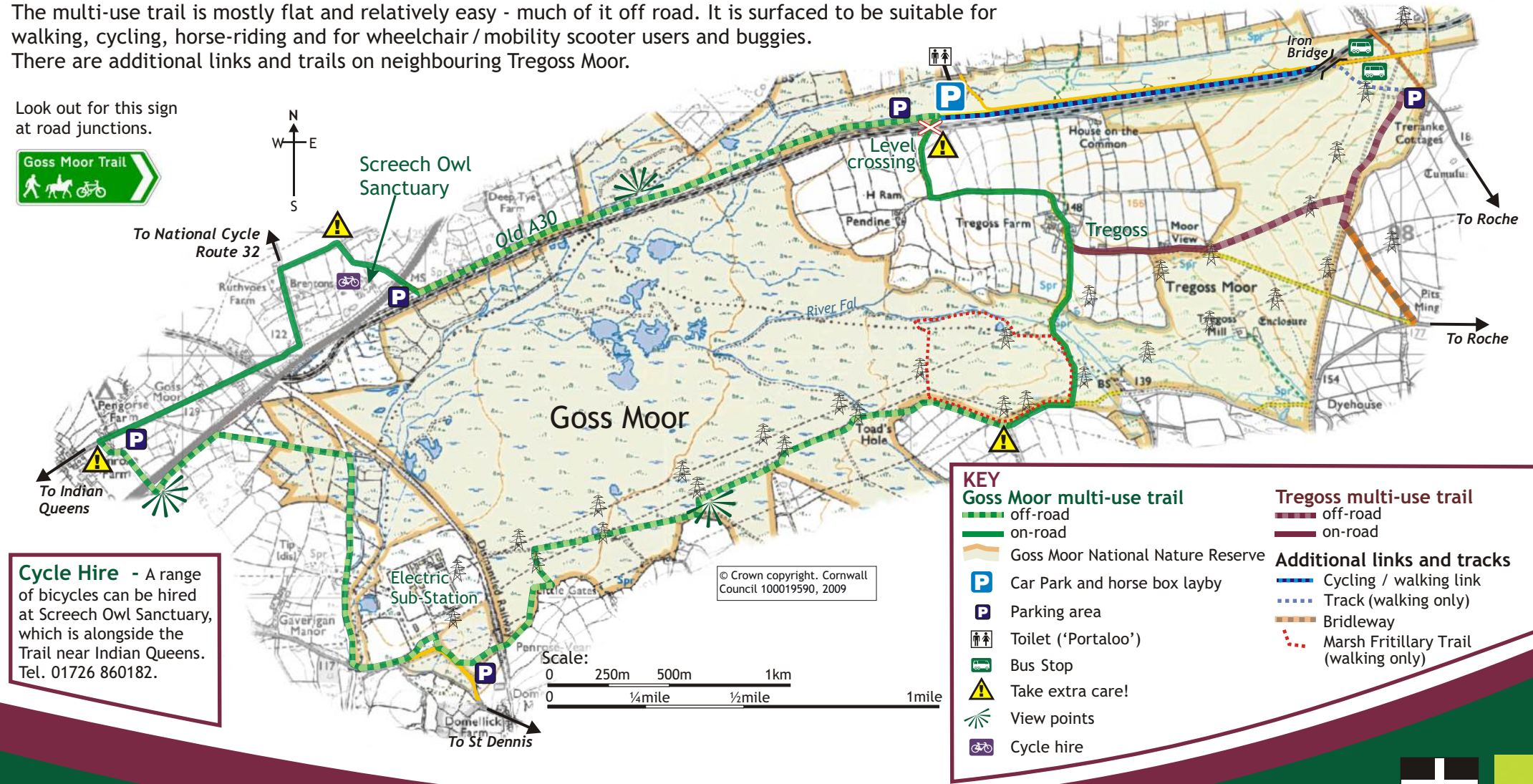


# Welcome to Goss Moor multi-use trail a'gas dynergh

This 7 mile (c.12km) circular trail provides a chance to explore the rich natural and industrial heritage of Goss Moor National Nature Reserve.

The multi-use trail is mostly flat and relatively easy - much of it off road. It is surfaced to be suitable for walking, cycling, horse-riding and for wheelchair / mobility scooter users and buggies. There are additional links and trails on neighbouring Tregoss Moor.

Look out for this sign at road junctions.
