

Changes to General Licences 2012

The below were changed in each general licence

- Change from 'Wildlife Licensing Unit' to 'Customer Services Wildlife Licensing' (due to the organisational re-structure in April 2011).
- Change of licence period to 1 January to end December 2012 (where applicable)

The following minor changes have also been made to GL04, GL05, GL06:
