NO 2 DECLARATION 2009

The land having a total area of 273.58 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the Parish(es) of Skipwith and Riccall in the County of North Yorkshire and shown single hatched and shaded yellow on the attached map(s) is the subject of an agreement (the Agreement) dated 1 December 2009 between Natural England and Charles David Forbes Adam under the provisions of section 7 of the Natural Environment and Rural Communities Act 2006.

The land the subject of the Agreement is being managed as a nature reserve.

Natural England is satisfied that the said land is of national importance.

In pursuance of section 19(1) of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and section 35(1) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England hereby declare the land referred to herein and more particularly shown on the map attached hereto a National Nature Reserve.

This Declaration may be referred to as the Skipwith Common National Nature Reserve No. 2 Declaration 2009
